### TWEED-NEW HAVEN AIRPORT AUTHORITY TWEED-NEW HAVEN REGIONAL AIRPORT REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

The Tweed-New Haven Airport Authority (TNHAA), Lessee/Operator of Tweed-New Haven Regional Airport (HVN) in the City of New Haven and Town of East Haven, Connecticut is requesting Statement of Qualifications from engineering firms with demonstrated professional competence in Airport Engineering for airside, terminal and landside facilities and ancillary features. The services to be provided shall include preparation of Design Drawings and Contract Documents, Permitting, Bid Phase services, Construction Phase services including Resident Engineering, and Closeout services.

These services are required for the implementation of near-term (2022-2026) Capital Improvement Program (CIP) projects at Tweed New Haven Regional Airport (HVN) identified in the recently conducted Airport Master Plan Update Study. TNHAA intends to select firms for inclusion in prequalified lists to whom Requests for Technical Proposals (RFP) would be issued for individual projects in the CIP.

Awards will not be made to any firm whose name appears on a debarred list from performing contracts for the Federal Government, the State of Connecticut or any agency of the foregoing.
