WHEREAS, The Auditor Michael Solakian has reviewed the draft FY 2025 Financial Statements and affirmed its content; and

RESOLUTION #636

RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE ACCEPTANCE OF NOISE MITIGATION FUNDS FROM THE CONNECTICUT AIRPORT AUTHORITY PURSUANT TO SECTION 13b-50c OF THE CONNECTICUT GENERAL STATUTES

April 15, 2026

WHEREAS, the State of Connecticut has imposed a tax on aviation fuel under Connecticut General Statutes (Conn. Gen. Stat.) § 12-587;

WHEREAS, the amounts received by the state from the imposition of the aviation fuel tax are required by Conn. Gen. Stat. § 13b-50c to be deposited to the Connecticut Airport and Aviation Account, a separate, nonlapsing account established within the Grants and Restricted Accounts Fund established pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 4-31c;

WHEREAS, funds in the Connecticut airport and aviation account are directed by Conn. Gen. Stat. §13b-50c to be expended by the executive director of the Connecticut Airport Authority, with the approval of the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, for airport and aviation-related purposes;

WHEREAS, the Connecticut General Assembly enacted Public Act 25-168, § 406 of which amended Conn. Gen. Stat. §13b-50c (a) to add a proviso to that section mandating that one million dollars (\$1,000,000) in said account shall be expended each fiscal year by CAA to be used by Tweed-New Haven Airport Authority ("TNHAA") for noise mitigation purposes in accordance with federal aviation regulations;

WHEREAS, TNHAA desires to accept such funds and expend them for the noise mitigation purposes required by Conn. Gen. Stat. §13b-50c (a);

WHEREAS, CAA has proposed that CAA and TNHAA enter into an agreement titled "Agreement Between the Connecticut Airport Authority and Tweed-New Haven Airport Authority for General Statutes § 13b-50c Funds for Noise Mitigation Purposes" (the "Disbursement Agreement") governing the process for disbursement of and oversight over the use of such funds as are mandated to be expended by CAA pursuant to the amendment of §13b-50c (a) during the state budget biennium that began on July 1, 2025 and will end on June 30, 2027;

WHEREAS, the Disbursement Agreement has been reviewed by TNHAA's Executive Director and legal counsel;

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WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the "Board") has been briefed on the content of the Disbursement Agreement and has had an opportunity for thorough discussion concerning the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board, duly constituted, hereby authorizes the Chair or the Vice Chair of the Board to execute the Disbursement Agreement in substantially the same form as the draft Disbursement Agreement attached to this resolution and authorizes the Executive Director and persons acting under his direction to execute ancillary documents reasonably requested by CAA or any taxing authority or financial institution to facilitate the receipt and expenditure of the funds disbursed by CAA for the purposes of §13b-50c (a).

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
